



Float Rules and Regulations

350th Celebration Grand Parade

September 16, 2023

Floats must comply with the following:

Specifications:

1. Size (maximum) – Width - 12 ft (excluding riggers), Height – 14 ft, Length – maneuverable
2. Size (minimum) – At least three (3) rolling wheels

Safety:

- Every float must be built in such a manner as to ensure the safety of its occupants and will be subject to inspection by the Wrentham Fire Department.
- Each float must have a fire extinguisher.
- No open flames will be allowed on floats.
- All exhaust systems must be in good condition and no exhaust system shall come into contact with flammable decorations.
- No smoking on floats.
- Drivers must be able to exit from float quickly in an emergency.

Registrations:

Every float which is propelled by an internal combustion engine must be dually registered.

Parade Route:

Float muster at the Rice Recreational Complex (Emerald Street).

Applications:

Applications must be submitted by June 1, 2023 to: Town Clerk, 79 South Street, Wrentham, MA 02093, or by email to wrentham350@gmail.com.

General Recommendations:

Flameproof materials should be used where possible. Exhaust pipes near flammable decorations should be wrapped and should clear the rear of the float.

Drivers should have good visibility and driver areas vented.

Vehicles should be in proper working condition.

Vehicles should have tow ring or other means to be towed if needed.
